ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Westmorland Motor Club Ltd will promote a Clubmans Sporting Car Trial on 27th February 2005 at Newton Fell, near Lindale, Cumbria
2. The Meeting will be governed by the General Competition Rules and Regulations of the MSA (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) these additional supplementary regulations and any written instructions promoting the Club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permit number has been issued.
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the promoting Club, the Northern Sporting Trials Car Club, Cumbria Phoenix Motor Club, Cumberland Sporting Car Club and Yorkshire Sporting Car Club.
5. The event will be held at Newton Fell, near Lindale, Cumbria (see map attached). Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 6 hills on private land, and at least 4 runs will be allowed at each hill. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills. Numbers will be drawn by ballot and issued when signing on.
6. Scrutineering will start at 10.00am. The event will start at 11.00am. Any competitor not signed on by 1030am may be excluded. There may be a lunch break after the first two runs at each hill have been concluded.
7. All cars will comply with the MSA Vehicle and Tyre Regulations and the National Trials Car Formula.
8. Awards will be presented as follows:
 - a) 1st Overall - The Quirk Trophy and replica
 - b) 2nd Overall - an award
 - c) 3rd Overall - an award
9. The maximum number of entries for the event is 40. The minimum number of entries for the event is 6. Should the minimum entry not be reached the Organisers have the right to cancel the meeting.
10. The entry list opens on receipt of these Regulations and closes in accordance with SSR B.10.3 not less than three days before the date of the event. The Club may entirely at its discretion accept entries up to one hour before the competition starts. All entries must be made on the Official Entry Form and accompanied by the fee of £15.00
11. Cars may be driven by more than one driver providing each complies with these additional supplementary regulations.
